

# Stryker Initial Maneuver Short Range Air Defense (IM-SHORAD)

- The Stryker IM-SHORAD vehicle will provide lethal, mobile and survivable air defense vs. an array of aerial threats.
- Based on the new Stryker A1 chassis, the IM-SHORAD will enable the Army's maneuver units for Multi-Domain Operations.
- Highlights:
  - On-board target-acquisition capability paired with the Army's Integrated Air and Missile Defense battle command systems
  - Hellfire missiles, Stinger missiles and a 30mm cannon
  - Crew of 3/4
  - Prototype vehicles delivered starting in November 2019
  - Testing is underway in 2020
  - New Equipment Training taking place July-October 2020
  - First Unit Equipped (FUE) projected in early 2021
